"GIVE A JOB!" - restoration of workplaces in Beirut, December 2020

- In December 2020 we helped to restore 4 workplaces
- Costs of works: **3905 USD** (including salary for professional labor Team)
- Works were conducted in cooperation with St. Michael Church in Mar Mikhail Beirut and Redemptoris Mater Liban (except support for miss Ewa Szumilas, which was provided directly from our Assosaction), with a great help of the volunteers from the neocatechumenal community
- Since August we've supported 17 wokplaces for 12 496 USD
- Works will be continued in the upcoming months according to the budget of Domus
 Orientalis and costs sharing with other entities

1. Gabi's Shop

About: Gabi is a very nice person owning a small shop. He needed a shelves to proceed with his small business.

Location: Rmeil

Works: Wood shelves for his shop

Costs: 500 USD





2. Cafe "Caffeine" – owned by Adib

About: "Caffeine" is a very stylish cafe destroyed during the blast. Owner Adib put a lot of his own money to restore it, and we decided to help him by making chester sofas in Chadies workshop

Location: Mar Mikhail, close to Internazionale Pub

Works: 2 chester sofa

Costs: 1330 USD + 170 USD paid by the owner





3. **Sarkis**

About: Sarkis owns a small shop in Armenian neighberhoud. He needed help in restoration of the broken glass, destroyed during the blast

Location: Burj Hammoud

Works: 3 broken glass, 1 aluminium facade

Costs: 75 USD





4. Ewa - "Das Kuche" Restaurant

About: Ewa and her husband own a popular restaurant with a polish dishes, which was completely destroyed in the explosion. Total costs of restoration were about 20 000 USD, we supported them with 2000 USD for the interior glass covers
